Filing or Requesting Non-emergency documents



Restrictions for filing in-person are in effect. All non-emergency filings must be filed by drop box, mail, fax, or turbo court. Requests for copies must be submitted in writing by mail, fax or drop box. Receipts for filings may be obtained by dropping documents at the walk-up window.

Courtroom Calendars



Calendared matters will continue with modified calendars & staggered hearings to practice social distancing. Telephonic appearances are highly encouraged and may be scheduled using Court Call or by contacting the courtroom directly. Only individuals and attorneys appearing on a case will be allowed into the courtroom.

Restricted Access



Only litigants and attorneys appearing on a case, or filing the following documents may enter the courthouse:

- Emergency Temporary Guardianship
- Emergency Temporary Conservatorship
- Special Letters (emergency)
- Ex Parte
- Elder Abuse Petitions for Protective Orders
- Behavioral Health
- Petition for Reestablishment of LPS Conservatorship
- Lodging of Wills
- Certificate of Orders and Letters with bond (only if heard that day)
- Peremptory Challenges (CCP 170.6/170.1)
