HEARINGS

The clerk's offices handling landlord tenant matters are directed to process the Status Conference hearings set for unlawful detainer matters. Upon the written or verbal request of the plaintiff or plaintiff's attorney, for no more than two requests, the clerk's office may continue the Status Conference hearing thirty (30) days from the current hearing date. Any third or subsequent request for continuance is to be submitted for judicial review. If there is no request for continuance and no subsequent filings beyond the summons and complaint, the clerk's office is directed to dismiss the unlawful detainer complaint.

General Order: Authority for Clerk's Office to Process Status Conference Hearings

This order is effective January 1, 2020, and supersedes all previous general orders entitled *Authority for Clerk's Office to Process Status Conference Hearings,* issued by previous Presiding Judges. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2021.
