SAN BERNARDINO SUPERIOR COURT HOSTS 3rd VIRTUAL TOWNHALL ON ELIMINATING BIAS

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— San Bernardino Superior Court's (SBSC) Community Outreach Committee is collaborating with local justice partners to host a third virtual townhall event focused on eliminating bias in the justice system. This third townhall entitled *Eliminating Bias: Addressing Mental Health in the Justice System* focuses on mental health issues within the justice system and is scheduled on Thursday, March 25 from 12:00 p.m. (Noon) to 1:15 p.m.

During this 75-minute virtual townhall, leaders within the San Bernardino County justice system will continue the conversation on bias and community impacts by answering questions and informing attendees of programs and services available to the public for family members, organizations, and individuals who suffer from mental illness. This will be the third virtual event in a series of townhalls scheduled to continue in the 2021 calendar year to promote community engagement and conversations to facilitate awareness, change and understanding.
